Curriculum Options:

1. Pre-purchased curriculum.
2. "Treasure-Builders" preschool. A guided outline for teaching material, and maps that go along with each unit. 9 units, each unit is made to last 4 weeks, with two lessons per week.
3. Own choice. Group chooses some topics, separates into sub categories, and each teacher comes up with their own lesson ideas
4. Alphabet recognition. How will we implement? The Alphabet Sounds Workbook (part of Treasure Builder's Preschool) focus' on the sounds each letter makes, as well as writing the letter. There are two activities per letter. Also helps with the fine motor skills of cutting/pasting.
5. Other ideas or focus you have liked?

2. Host the class in your home when it is your turn to teach. Each parent must feel comfortable with this option.
